Conductive Education (CE) is a unique holistic educational system for children with motor difficulties (physical disability) and associated special needs.



WHO BENEFITS?

CE helps children and adults with motor disabilities to develop the skills necessary to experience greater levels of independence and success in everyday life.

WHY?

To develop fundamental skills (such as sitting, walking, communicating and self care) that come naturally to children without special needs, producing fantastic results where more traditional learning systems have been unsuccessful.

A GROWING NEED!

There is a growing wait list for children wishing to access CE in Western Australia. The wait list is growing due to: increasing knowledge about this fantastic program; a shortage of appropriately qualified and trained teacher conductors to lead the specialised programmes; as well as funding issues.
